Performance Plan

In an effort to maintain a reasonable scope for this performance improvement project, the team has chosen to focus the Mega, Macro and Micro level goals in this Performance Plan specifically on the Curriculum & Instruction (C&I) online Master's degree program at the Curry School of Education. However, we acknowledge similar Mega goals could apply to other Master's degree programs at the Curry School.

The Performance Plan is based on Kaufman's OEM model (1999). Five gaps and corresponding performance statements identified by the needs assessment form the areas of consideration. The Mega goals are fairly consistent across all five areas. The Macro and Micro goals are differentiated based on the area specified in the gap statement. The Performance Plan was informed by Guerra and Rodriquez' (2005) plan for the Sonora Institute of Technology and Ghumman's (2014) plan for a Curry online program.

The team evaluated objectives, written to identify results (Ends), with the 7-Point Check from Moore, Ellsworth, and Kaufman (2008).

1. Good Online Instruction

Performance Statement: Faculty members have a clear understanding of what high-quality, community-developing online instruction looks like based on agreed-upon characteristics established through a collaborative process. Instructional faculty translate their understanding of high-quality online instruction with high fidelity to established characteristics.

Gap Statement: Instructional faculty need to know what good online instruction looks like. They do not have models or agreed upon internal standards of high-quality to aid development and evaluation of effective and engaging online courses.

2. Guidelines for Creating Courses

Performance Statement: Instructional faculty members have clear guidelines to follow as they set up classes. This includes consistency in the layout of course websites, selected tools, organizational structure of classes (e.g., systematic discussion post timing), and general norms for classes (e.g., approximately uniform student workloads). Instructional faculty establish these guidelines through a collaborative process. Support staff are aware of these guidelines to best support consistency.

Gap Statement: Faculty do not have clear guidelines to create online courses that are consistent, nor a process for collaboratively creating these guidelines. Faculty need a clear system and meeting time for content and pedagogy-oriented communication and knowledge-sharing.

3. Recognition of Time Involved

Performance Statement: Faculty members receive recognition in alignment with the additional time it takes to create and manage an online course based on analytic data of time spent relative to course type. Performance evaluations and professionally significant formal recognition are used to reward faculty in addition to or in lieu of financial incentives, subject to the availability of monetary resources.

Gap Statement: Faculty need to receive recognition for the additional time needed to create online programs. Due to limited financial resources, this recognition cannot currently be financial. There is a lack of feedback and accountability structure on annual reviews and other Curry policy material to provide for non-financial recognition.

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4. Level and Use of Technical Support

Performance Statement: A devoted support staff is readily available to help faculty members combat technical issues. A system for communicating technical challenges reliably and quickly is in place. The system allows support staff to prioritize instructional faculty needs and respond within a set time in order of the importance of the request.

Gap Statement: Faculty need a dedicated support staff available to provide assistance with initial creation of online courses and to provide ongoing support. Current resources need to be more efficiently allocated based on prioritization of support needs.

In addition to the amount of time, faculty lack readily available technical support to make most effective use of their time in the development and execution of online courses.
